Book of Prayers

Introduction to prayers:

In Jesus we see the heart of the Father. He never refused to help anyone; he was always ready, willing and able to help. The only time that he could do no mighty works was when the people refused to believe. The same is true today; He is ready, willing, and able to help us, and the only time He can't help us is when we refuse to believe. The traditions of mankind can make the Word of God of no effect.

There is a promise of God that can enable us to overcome anything that comes against us (*II Peter 1:4*).
There is sufficient power in the Word of God to overcome anything that comes against us (*Isaiah 55:11*).
There is sufficient power in the Word to cause itself to come to pass (*Isaiah 61:11*).
God watches over his Word to perform it (*Ezekiel 12:25*).

Anything we can see, hear, or feel is temporal, the spirit realm is eternal. The spirit realm created the physical and the spirit realm can change the physical. The Word of God framed the universe; we have been created in His image, and our words can frame our world. Just like Abraham (*Romans 4*), he called things that were not as though they were, and did not consider circumstances contrary to God's Word. He did not deny the circumstances existed, but He believed God in spite of the circumstances, and God considered Abraham's belief and confession to be righteous.

The following are just a few scriptures regarding the words we speak.

Negative:

Proverbs 18:7. A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul.

James 3:5,6. The tongue is a little member, and boast of great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindles! The tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

Positive:

Job 22:28. You shall decree a thing, and it shall be established unto you; and the light shall shine upon your ways.

Proverbs 4:20-22. My son, attend to my words; incline your ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

Proverbs 10:11. The mouth of a righteous man is a well of life.

Proverbs 12:14. A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompense of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.

Proverbs 12:18. The tongue of the wise is health.

Proverbs 13:3. He that keeps his mouth keeps his life.

Proverbs 15:2. The tongue of the wise uses knowledge aright.

Proverbs 15:4. A wholesome tongue is a tree of life.

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Proverbs 16:24. Pleasant words are as a honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

Proverbs 18:21. Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Proverbs 21:23. Whosoever keeps his mouth and his tongue keeps his soul from troubles.

Isaiah 57:19. I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, says the Lord; and I will heal him.

Psalms 107:20. He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Isaiah 55:11. So shall my word be that goes forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

John 6:63. It is the spirit that makes alive; the flesh profits nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. *Luke 6:45.* A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks. *John 14:13,14.* Whatsoever you shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you shall ask anything in my name, I will do it. *John 15:7.* If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. *Matthew 16:19.* I will give unto you the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

To summarize some of the salient points in the scriptures above:

Death and life are in our tongue; our words "set on fire the course of nature"; from the abundance of our heart our lips will speak. Continually speaking doubt and unbelief or existing negative situations and circumstances can be destructive to our health and well-being. Jesus came to give us an abundant life; and speaking God's Word in faith in the Name of Jesus, will produce life, peace, and health for our soul (mind, will, & emotion) and body.

These promises of God are conditional; we must abide in Jesus, let his Word abide in us, and pray according to *Mark 11:23-24*, believe we receive, and we shall have whatever we desire. The Word of God must be more real to us than the words and reports of people, more real than our feelings, more real than our traditions, and more real than what circumstances indicate.

When God's Word becomes engrafted into our spirit it becomes a part of us. It cannot be separated from us. It is not only our thought and affirmation; it is part of our being. When we speak God's Word from our heart, then faith gives substance to the promises of God. Our faith frames our world daily; as Jesus said, "a good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things."

When our body is attacked by disease or injury, it seems people are continually asking us how we feel, or about the diagnosis or prognosis. Doctors and nurses are telling us about the typical harmful affects of the disease and the harmful side-affects of the medicines prescribed. We are given books and pamphlets entitled "Living with whatever". Looking at the materials and speaking about the disease and its effects, attack the image of health that the Holy Spirit is trying to create in us. If we are experiencing pain resulting from the disease, it adds to the difficulty of keeping our faith strong.

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We must remember that God's Word is true regardless of the diagnosis, or how we feel. When we confess our healing, we are not denying the sickness exists, we are denying its right to exist in our body, and we are claiming the Word of God and the Blood of Jesus is more powerful than the attack of Satan.

Maybe you have sinned and feel like a hypocrite even talking to God. He knows that all of us have sinned and fallen short of His Glory. Jesus Christ willingly gave His blood and His life for sinners. Everyone qualifies to receive His mercy and grace. He willingly became sin, so that we could be righteous in the eyes of the Father. Flesh and blood is sinful; and we will be challenged the rest of our lives to grow in grace. If it were not for the mercy, grace, and lovingkindness of our Lord, no one would be justified. When you sin, don't run from Him; run to Him, ask for forgiveness, repent, and, like Abraham, "Call things that are not as though they are". God's commandments are rigid orders and strict laws, and God has commanded blessings on his people. As his people you can command (speak) those blessings into your life and the lives of others.

The prayers we have compiled "personalize" scriptures in the Bible; therefore, we can be assured we are praying the will of the Father; when we pray we are not asking the Father to change His will regarding any request; we are praying according to His Word. Also, Old Testament scriptures have been "updated" to New Testament revelation (i.e. "love your Law", would be updated to "love your Word"). In many cases similar thoughts from various scriptures (and various translations) have been synthesized into one theme with scripture references provided. In some cases conditional promises are changed to affirmative statements. For instance, the Lord's Prayer says, "forgive us our sins, as we forgive others". Jesus explained that if we do not forgive others, the Father would not forgive us. Therefore our prayer should be, "Father we forgive all who have wronged us, and we ask that You to forgive us of our sins."

Don't rush through the prayers merely saying the words. Meditate on the words and phrases and try to grasp just how much God the Father and Jesus Christ loves you, and try to understand how much the Holy Spirit wants to help you. The Word of God is the most powerful force in the universe, and Jesus the Living Word has been placed far above all principalities and powers and names in this world and in the world to come. The authority to use the Word of God has been given to the children of God. The Father expects us to know His Word and use it. Satan is a thief; do not allow him to keep anything he has stolen from you. By our words we will be justified, and by our words we will be condemned. Agree with God, speak His Word, and make it the controlling force in your life. Jesus is the High Priest of your confession. Fear not, take your position in the Body of Christ, and in the mighty Name of Jesus speak the Word of Faith; believe that Jehovah will watch over His Word to perform it. Do not consider circumstances, or dwell on your problems. Be a blessing to others and display God's Glory in the earth.

Praise the Lord

(Psalms 9:1-2): I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will show forth all your marvelous works. I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praises to your name, O Most High.

(Psalms 118:24): This is the day which You have made; I will rejoice and be glad in it.

(Psalms 84:10-12): A day in your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness. For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly; blessed are those who trust in You.

(Psalms 100): Make a joyful noise unto Jehovah, all ye lands. Serve the Lord with gladness; come before His presence with singing. Know that Jehovah, He is God; it is He that has made us; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Give thanks unto Him and bless His name, for Jehovah is good; His mercy and lovingkindness endure forever, and His faithfulness unto all generations.

(Psalms 95:1-3,6-7): Let us sing unto the Lord: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto Him with psalms. For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods. Let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the Lord our maker; for He is our God; and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand.

(Psalms 104:33-34): I will sing unto the Lord as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. My meditation of Him shall be sweet; I will be glad in the Lord.

(Psalms 103): Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me; bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul and forget not all His benefits. You forgive all our iniquities; You heal all our diseases; You redeem our lives from destruction; You crown us with lovingkindness and tender mercies; You satisfy our desires with good things, so that our youth is renewed like the eagle, strong and overcoming. You execute righteous acts, and judgments for all that are oppressed. You make known your ways unto us. You are merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abundant in lovingkindness. You have not dealt with us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. We reverence You, Lord, and remember your covenant and precepts, and great is Your lovingkindness towards us, as the heavens are high above the earth. You have removed our transgressions far from us, as far as the east is from the west, and your lovingkindness towards us is from everlasting to everlasting.

(Psalms 1, 2, 3,4): Blessed are we who do not walk in the counsel of the wicked, nor stand in the way of sinners, nor sit in the seat of scoffers, but our delight is in the Word of God. We meditate on your Word day and night, and your Word strengthens, protects, and prospers us. We are like a tree planted by streams of water, our leaf does not wither, we bring forth fruit in our due season, and whatever we do shall prosper and not fail. You are our shield and fortress, and the lifter of our heads. We shall not be afraid; You have put gladness in our hearts, and we can lie down in peace and sleep, for we dwell in safety.

(Psalms 23): The Lord is our shepherd; You feed, guide and protect us, and we shall have no lack in anything. You make us lie down in fresh green tender pastures; You lead us beside still peaceful waters. You restore our souls (we allow your Word to renew our mind, and the Holy Spirit to control our will and emotion). You lead us in the paths of righteousness for your name's sake. Yea, though we walk through the valley of the shadow of death, we will fear no evil, for You are with us; your rod will protect us, and your staff will guide us, and they give us comfort. You prepare a table before us in the presence of our enemies; You anoint our heads with oil; our joy is overflowing. Surely, goodness, mercy and your unfailing lovingkindness shall follow us all the days of our lives, and we shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

(Psalms 91): We dwell in the secret place of the Most High, whose power no foe can withstand, and abide under the shadow of the Almighty. We say of Jehovah, "You are our refuge and our fortress; our God, in whom we confidently trust and rely. You will deliver us from the snare of the fowler, and from the deadly pestilence. As a mother hen shields her chicks from danger, You cover us with your wings, and under your wings we take refuge and trust; your truth and faithfulness are our shield and armor. We are not afraid of terror, weapons, pestilence, destruction, evil plots, or slanderers. Even though thousands may fall around us, it will not come near us, because You are our refuge and our habitation; and there shall no evil befall us, neither shall any plague come near us, for You have given your angels charge over us, to keep us in all our ways and they shall protect us, lest at any time we be injured or harmed. We shall tread upon the lion and adder, and trample them under our feet. We have set our love upon You, and You will deliver us because we have known your name, and know your love, mercy, kindness, and faithfulness. We know You will never leave us or forsake us. When we call, You will answer; and You will deliver us, honor us, and satisfy us with long life."

(Psalms 92): It is good to give thanks unto Jehovah, and to sing praises unto your name, O Most High; to show forth your lovingkindness in the morning, and your faithfulness every night, with an instrument of ten strings, the psaltery; and the harp. For You, Jehovah, have made us glad through your work. How great are your works, O Jehovah! We will triumph in the works of your hands. Your thoughts are very deep. Uncultured mankind knows not, neither does a self-confident fool understand that when the wicked spring up as the grass, and when the workers of iniquity flourish; that their end is everlasting destruction. But You, O Jehovah, are on high forevermore. Your enemies, O Jehovah, shall perish; and all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. Our horns You have exalted like the horn of the wild-ox, You have anointed us with fresh oil, and You have increased our strength and grace. Our eyes have seen and our ears have heard the consequence of treacherous people that have risen against us. We shall flourish like the palm-tree, long-lived, stately, upright, useful, and fruitful. We shall grow like the cedars of Lebanon, majestic, stable, durable, and incorruptible. We are planted in the house of Jehovah; we shall flourish in the courts of our God, growing in grace. We shall still bring forth fruit in our old age; we shall be full of spiritual vitality and rich in love, integrity, and contentment, to show that Jehovah is upright and faithful to His promises. You are our rock, and there is no unrighteousness in You.

(Psalms 90:16-17): Lord, let your work and glory appear unto us, and let the beauty, delightfulness, and favor of the Lord our God be upon us; confirm and establish the work that You have called us to do.

(Psalms 112): Praise the Lord. Blessed are we, who reverence the Lord, we delight greatly in your Word. Our children, grandchildren and their descendants shall be mighty upon earth, and they shall be blessed. Wealth and riches are in our homes, and our righteousness endures forever. Unto us there arises light in the darkness; we are gracious, merciful, righteous, and full of compassion. We deal graciously and lend, and have no reason to borrow, because Jehovah Jireh is our provider; we shall conduct our affairs with discretion and prudence. We shall never be moved; we shall be in everlasting remembrance. We shall not be afraid of evil reports; our heart is fixed and established, confidently trusting in Jehovah. Our heart is established; we shall not be afraid, and we shall see our desire upon our adversaries. We have freely distributed to the poor and needy; our righteousness endures forever; our horn (strength and grace) shall be exalted with honor. The wicked shall see it, and be grieved; they shall gnash with their teeth, and melt away; the desire of the wicked shall perish.

(Psalms 19: 7-14): The Word of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple; the statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes; the reverence of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether; more to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Cleanse us from secret faults; keep us from arrogant sins; let them not have dominion over us; let the words of our mouth, and the meditation of our heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, our strength, and our redeemer.

(1 Chron. 16: 23-29): Sing unto the Lord, all the earth; show forth from day to day His salvation. We declare Your glory among the heathen, and Your marvelous works among all nations; for great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; You are also to be feared above all gods; for all the gods of the people are idols: but You have made the heavens. Glory and honor are in Your presence; strength and gladness are in Your place. Glory and strength belong to the Lord, and we give You the glory due unto Your name; we bring offerings, and come before You and worship the Lord in beauty of holiness.

(1 Chron. 29: 10-13): Blessed be the Lord God our Father, forever and ever. Yours, O Lord is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty; for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head above all. Riches and honor come from You, and You reign over all; and in Your hand is power and might; and You make great, and give strength unto all. Now therefore, our God, we thank You, and praise Your glorious name.

Prayer for Zion

(Isaiah 28, 1 Peter 2) Thus says the Lord God Jehovah, behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; and he that believes on Him shall not be put to shame. *(Ephesians 2)* We are established on the foundation of our spiritual ancestors who have preceded us in the earth, with Christ Jesus himself being the chief cornerstone. In Him the whole structure is bound together, and we, individually and collectively, continue to grow and increase in Zion, a holy temple in the Lord, a sanctuary dedicated, consecrated and sacred to the presence of the Lord. *(Psalms 50)* Out of Zion, a perfection of beauty, God will shine forth. *(Psalms 65)* Praise waits for God in Zion, and *(Psalms 76)* God's name is great in Zion. *(Psalms 84)* Blessed are we whose strength is in thee; let our hearts be highways to Zion. We go from strength to strength for our hearts appear to God in Zion. *(Psalms 87)* The Most High shall establish Zion.

(Psalms 97) Zion heard and was glad, and the daughters of Judah rejoiced, because of thy judgments, O Jehovah, for You are most high above all the earth. You are exalted far above all gods. We that love Jehovah hate evil; and He preserves our souls, and He delivers us out of the hand of the wicked.

(Psalms 99) Jehovah is great in Zion. *(Psalms 102)* Jehovah has mercy on Zion, Jehovah will build up Zion, and we will declare the name of Jehovah in Zion. *(Psalms 110)* Jehovah will send forth the rod of His strength out of Zion. *(Psalms 125)* We that trust in Jehovah are as mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever. *(Psalms 128)* Jehovah will bless those in Zion, and we shall see the good of Jerusalem all the days of our lives. *(Psalms 129)* All those that hate Zion shall be put to shame. *(Psalms 132)* Jehovah has chosen Zion; He has desired it for His habitation. *(Psalms 133)* Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for children to dwell together in unity! It is like precious oil upon the head, that flows down and covers the body, like the dew of Hermon, that comes down upon the mountains of Zion, for there Jehovah commands the blessing, even life for evermore. *(Psalms 135)* Blessed be Jehovah out of Zion, who dwells in Jerusalem. *(Psalms 149)* Praise ye Jehovah. Sing unto Jehovah a new song, and His praise in the assembly of the saints. Let Israel rejoice in Him that made us; let the children of Zion be joyful in our King; let us praise His name in the dance; let us sing praises unto Him; for Jehovah takes pleasure in His people. He will beautify the meek with salvation; let us rejoice in glory; let us sing for joy; let the high praises of God be in our mouth. *(Isaiah 12)* Cry aloud and shout, inhabitants of Zion; for great in the midst of thee is the Holy One of Israel. *(Isaiah 30)* For we who dwell in Zion shall weep no more, for Jehovah will surely be gracious unto us. When we cry, He will hear, and He will answer us. *(Isaiah 35)* The ransomed of Jehovah shall return, and come with singing unto Zion, and everlasting joy shall be upon our heads. We shall obtain gladness and joy, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

(Joel 2) Blow the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in His holy mountain; let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for the day of Jehovah comes, it is near at hand. Be glad children of Zion, and rejoice in Jehovah our God, for He gives us the former rain in just measure, and He causes the rain to come down for us, both the former rain and the latter rain in the first month. Our floors shall be full of wheat, and our vats shall overflow with new wine and oil. Jehovah shall restore unto us the years that the locust and worms have eaten. We shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, and shall praise the name of Jehovah our God, who has dealt wondrously with us; His people shall never be put to shame. We shall know that Jehovah is in the midst of Israel, and that Jehovah is our God, and there is none else; His people shall never be put to shame. It shall come to pass, that He will pour out His Spirit upon all flesh, and our sons and our daughters shall prophesy, our old men shall dream dreams, our young men shall see visions, and upon the servants and handmaids He will pour out His Spirit. He will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth. *(Joel 3)* Jehovah will roar from Zion and utter His voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake, but Jehovah will be a refuge unto His people and a stronghold to the children of Israel. So shall we know that Jehovah is our God, dwelling in Zion His Holy Mountain; then shall Jerusalem be holy, and no strangers shall pass through her any more. It shall come to pass in that day, the mountains shall drop down sweet wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the brooks of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth from the house of Jehovah, and shall water the valley. *(Zechariah 9)* Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem; behold, thy King comes unto thee; He is just, and has salvation. *(Revelation 14)* And I saw, and behold, the Lamb standing on mount Zion, and with Him a hundred and forty four thousand, having His name, and the name of His Father, written on their foreheads. I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder, and the voice that I heard was as the voice of harps playing, and they sang a new song before the throne.

Confession, Repentance, and Renewal:

(Nehemiah 9:33; Isaiah 6:5-7; Psalms 51; Psalms 19:12-14; Psalm 139:23-24; Psalm 141:3-4; Psalms 119:133; Psalms 69:5-6; Psalms 26:2-3; Mat 25:21; 1 John 1:7; 1 Corinthians 6:19; Proverbs 3:6; Romans 6:11; Proverbs 3:21,22; Romans 12:1,2; Psalms 119:105; Joshua 1:8; James 1:19-20; Hebrews 13:12; John 17:17; Matt 6:12; Mark 11:25)

Lord, You know my foolishness and my sins are not hidden from You. You have been just in all that has happened to me; You have been faithful, while I have sinned. May those who hope in You not be embarrassed because of me; may those who seek You not be confused because of me. Woe is me! For I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of Hosts. Burn iniquity from my lips, take away my iniquity and purge my sins. Have mercy upon me O God, according to your lovingkindness, according to the multitude of your tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin; for I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against You have I sinned, and done evil in your sight. Cleanse me from secret faults, keep me from arrogant sins; let them not have dominion over me; then I shall be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean, wash me in the Blood of the Lamb, and I shall be cleansed of my sin. Let me hear joy and gladness, I will rejoice at your correction. Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. Cast me not away from your presence; and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of your salvation; and uphold me with your free spirit; then will I teach transgressors your ways; and sinners shall be converted unto You. Deliver me from blood guiltiness, O God, the God of my salvation, and my tongue shall sing aloud of your righteousness. O Lord, open my lips; and my mouth shall show forth your praise, for You do not desire sacrifice or offering; my sacrifices to You are a broken spirit, a broken and a repentant heart; then I will offer the sacrifices of righteousness and offerings. I forgive all who have wronged me. Examine me, O Lord, and establish me; purify my mind and my heart. Your lovingkindness is continually before my eyes; and I have walked in your truth. Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me, and know my thoughts; and see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. Help me to always remember that I have been bought with the blood of Jesus, and I am not my own, and my body is the temple of the Holy Spirit; and that I am dead unto sin, and alive unto God through Jesus Christ my Lord. Help me to walk in the light, as You are in the light. Help me Lord to not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of my mind, that I may prove what is the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God for my life. Set a watch, O Lord, before my mouth; and keep the door of my lips. Do not let my heart be inclined to any evil, or to practice iniquity. Create in me a clean pure heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. I desire truth and wisdom within my soul. I present my body a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto You, which is my reasonable service. Sanctify me through your Blood, and your truth; your Word is truth; and I keep your Word in my heart, and keep sound wisdom and discretion, so shall they be life to my soul, and a grace around my neck. Your Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path. Your Word shall not depart from me; but I shall meditate therein day and night, that I may observe to do according to all that is written therein, then shall I be prosperous and have good success. Order my steps in Your Word, and do not let any iniquity have dominion over me. Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer. Let me be swift to hear, slow to speak, and slow to wrath, for I know the wrath of man does not allow the righteousness of God to prevail. I do not trust in my own understanding, but I acknowledge the Lord my God in all my ways, and believe that You direct my paths. The desire of my heart is that one day I will hear You say, "Well done, good and faithful servant".

(Romans 12, Galatians 5, 1 Corinthians 13): I make my body a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to You; do not let me be conformed to this world, but let me be transformed by the renewing of my mind, that I may live in the perfect will of my God. Let me be led by the Holy Spirit and walk in the Spirit. Let me have no unrestrained thought; I reject every imagination and everything that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. I crucify the works of the flesh in my life: adultery, fornication, immorality, impurity, indecency, sorcery, hatred, envy, jealousy, wrath, strife, greed, selfishness, lying, subversion, rebellion, heresy, murder, drunkenness, and gluttony. Do not let me be prideful, conceited, vain, rude, foolish, condescending, scornful, critical, slanderous, offensive, improper, unbecoming, inappropriate, self-serving, resentful, deceitful, abusive, bitter, fearful, or easily provoked to anger, and do not let me provoke others. *(Gal 2:20) (Rom 6:8-14)* I am crucified with Christ; nevertheless I live; for Christ lives in me; and the life that I live in the flesh, I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Therefore, sin shall not reign in my mortal body, that I should obey it's lusts, and I shall not yield myself as an instrument of unrighteousness unto sin; rather I will yield myself unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and my body as an instrument of righteousness unto God; for sin shall not have dominion over me; for I am not under the law, but under grace. *(1 Cor 6:19-20)* Lord let me always be mindful that my body is the temple of the Holy Spirit which is in me, which I have received of God, and I am not my own; for I have been bought with a price most precious, the Blood of Jesus Christ, therefore let me glorify God in my body, and in my spirit, which belong to God. *(Rom 8:13-17)* Lord I pray that I will not live after the flesh; but through the Spirit, mortify the deeds of the body, and live. I pray that I will be led by the Spirit of God, as the son of God; for I have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but I have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby I cry, Abba, Father; and the Spirit bears witness with my spirit, that I am a child of God; and if a child, then an heir; and joint-heir with Christ.

Prayer for Healing

(Proverbs 4: 20-22) Lord, your Words are life and health to all our flesh.

(Isaiah 53: 5) You were wounded for our transgressions, You were bruised for our iniquities; You were chastised so we could have peace; and by your stripes we have been healed.

(1 Peter 2: 24) You bore our sins in your body on the cross, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness; and by your stripes we have been healed.

(2 Corinthians 5:21) Jesus knew no sin, but He was made to be sin for us, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.

(Galatians 3:13) Jesus Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us.

(Colossians 1:13,14) The Lord has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son, in whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins.

(John 10:10-11) Jesus came so that we might have life, and have it more abundantly. He is our good Shepherd; and He has given His life for us.

(Matthew 8:17) You took our infirmities, and bore our sicknesses.

(Psalms 107:20) You sent your Word and healed us, and delivered us from destruction.

(Romans 5:5) The love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost, which You gave to us.

(1 John 4:4) Greater is He that is in us, than he that is in the world.

(Colossians 1: 20-22) We have peace with God through the blood of the cross, and Jesus has reconciled us unto God, and He has presented us holy, free of sin and guilt in His sight.

(1 Corinthians 6:19) We have been bought with the blood of Jesus, and we are not our own, our body is the temple of the Holy Ghost.

(Romans 6:11) We are dead unto sin, and alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

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(Proverbs 3:21,22) We present our bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is our reasonable service. We keep your Word in our heart, and keep sound wisdom and discretion, so shall they be life to our soul, and a grace around our neck.

(John 6:63) The words that Jesus has spoken to us are spirit, and they are life.

(Proverbs 4:20-22) Lord, we attend to your words; we incline our ear unto your sayings. Your words do not depart from our eyes; we keep them in the midst of our heart, for they are life unto us, and health to all our flesh.

(Proverbs 3:6) We acknowledge the Lord our God in all our ways, and He directs our paths.

(Romans 12:1,2) We are not conformed to this world, but we are transformed by the renewing of our mind, that we may prove what is the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God for our life.

(Revelation 12:11) We overcome Satan by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of our testimony.

(Matt 6:12)(Mark 11:25) We forgive all who have wronged us, and we ask You to forgive us of our sins.

(Exodus 23:25,26) We shall serve the Lord our God, and He shall bless our bread and water; and He will take sickness away from us; and we shall live a full healthy life.

(Deuteronomy 34:7) As God was with Moses, so He is with us, our eyes are not dim; neither are our natural forces abated.

(Psalms 118:17) We shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.

Mark 11:22-24 Jesus said unto them, *"Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be removed, and cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he says shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he says. Therefore I say unto you, what things you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them".*

We speak according to *Mark 11:22-24* and say:

We have faith in our God; You are Jehovah Rapha to us, You are our Healer.

We speak to disease in our body and say, be removed, and cast out.

Our bone marrow produces pure blood that wards off sickness and disease, our immune system is strong and functions as God designed it to function; and our body is in perfect chemical balance.

Your Word has imparted life, health, and peace unto us.

That which God has not planted in us is dissolved and rooted out of our body in Jesus Name.

Growths, tumors, clots, viruses, arthritis, cancers, and infections, are dissolved and eliminated from our body in the Name of Jesus.

The Word of God and the Life of God restores our body with every breath we breathe and every word we speak.

We believe all medicines and treatments we take will work effectively, and there will be no negative side effects.

We believe we receive our healing, and shall walk in health all the days of our life; and we shall have a long productive life in the Name of Jesus.

Tithing the Tithe

(Deuteronomy 8, 26; Joshua 1; Psalms 1, 35, 37, 115; Proverbs 1, 2, 3, 4; Malachi 1, 2, 3; Matthew 6; Luke 6; Acts 10; II Corinthians 9; II Timothy 3; James 1): Lord, we were at one time under the control of Satan, and he came to kill, steal, and destroy us, and we had no hope. Thank You for wonderful families, children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren, who are whole and healthy, smart, beautiful, full of wisdom, and protected from all harm by their guardian angels. They have homes filled with love and free of strife, and they have happy hearts. Their heritage is of the Lord God Almighty; they are taught of the Lord; they are growing up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and great is their peace and undisturbed composure. No weapon formed against them will succeed; God contends with those who contend with them. Those who suppress our children will be consumed, and any tongue that rises against them in judgment, You will judge. Lord You keep them safe and ease them with your peace; their angels are before your face continually, and out of the mouths of our children You have perfected praise, joy, strength, and power. They are a blessing to us and to their heavenly Father. Satan and his angels are bound from hindering or hamming them in any way. They are thoroughly furnished for every good work; You make the crooked ways straight for them and give them creativity and strategies. Show us the results of believing the lies of the world, the flesh, and Satan, do not let us be deceived. Give us the words to speak to those who have been taken captive by the lies of Satan, so they can learn the Truth and be set free.

Prayer for Nation and Allies

Lord God, we pray for our nation; do not let the voice of them be heard who would remove You and your Word from our government. Let your laws and justice be established in our land; move on the hearts of our leaders and remove perverted laws from our land; do not let our laws and justice be perverse. Remove perverse leaders from their position, do not let their voice be heard, and give us godly leaders who seek your Word, your will, and your wisdom. We pray for the citizens of our nation and our allies, especially Israel, and we ask for your divine protection. We ask that You provide supernatural protection and knowledge to our military, homeland security, law enforcement, and allies regarding plans, activities, names, and locations of terrorists and those who would harm us. Give them wisdom to develop counterstrategies to stop the terrorists before they get started. If the terrorists do not repent, confuse our enemies Lord, and let them be victims of their own devices before your people are injured.

Prayer for Wisdom

(Proverbs 1-4): Lord we want to receive your instruction, knowledge, understanding and wisdom. Give us discernment and help us to guide our affairs with discretion and prudence. We desire your reproof; fill us with your spirit and revelation knowledge of your counsel. Let your words be a grace upon our heads and as jewelry around our necks. You founded the earth by wisdom, and by understanding You established the heavens; by your knowledge the depths were broken up, and the skies drop down the dew. We do not let the words of wisdom depart from our eyes; we keep sound wisdom and discretion, so shall they be life unto our soul, and grace to our necks. We shall walk securely in our way, and our foot shall not stumble. When we lie down, we shall not be afraid, and our sleep shall be sweet.

We shall not be afraid of the desolation of the wicked when it comes, for Jehovah will be our confidence and will keep us from harm. We hear the instruction of our father, contemplate to know and understand your words, and get wisdom and understanding. We will not forget or forsake your words, and Wisdom will preserve us. We love her, and she will keep us; we exalt her, and she will promote us. We embrace her and she will bring us honor. She will give to our heads a crown of grace and beauty, and grace us with long life. Teach us in the way of wisdom, and lead us in paths of righteousness; let us follow a straight path, and do not let us stumble. We hold fast to our instruction and do not let her go; we keep her, for she is our life. We will not enter into the path of the wicked, and we will not walk in the way of evil. We keep our heart with vigilance (we are watchful and alert) and diligence (we have a sustained effort), for we know that out of our heart will flow the issues of life (the fruit of the spirit). Help us to show forth your love in the earth and bear the fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness, kindness, faithfulness, temperance, and meekness; help us to be tenderhearted, compassionate, understanding, forgiving, resilient, and faithful. Let us live purposefully and worthy of bearing the name of Christian. We will rejoice when righteousness and truth prevail. We have unfailing hope in your promises, and we know your Love never fails. We have forsaken a rebellious mouth, and perverse lips we have put far from us. Our eyes look right on and straight before us. Let all our ways be established, and do not let us turn to the right or to the left; keep us from evil.

(Isaiah 55-56): Lord we forsake our ways and thoughts, and we trust in and rely on You because we know your thoughts and ways are higher than ours; have mercy upon us and pardon us. As the rain comes down from heaven and waters the earth, bringing forth fruit and providing nourishment, so shall your words go forth and not return void, but they shall accomplish that which You please, and your words shall prosper where You desire. And we shall go out with joy, be led forth with peace, and the mountains and the hills shall break forth with singing, and all the trees of the fields shall clap their hands. Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir-tree; and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle-tree; and it shall be to Jehovah an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off. We shall keep justice and do righteousness, knowing your salvation is near, and your righteousness will be revealed. We shall not profane your Sabbath and we shall restrain from doing evil. Persecution, affliction, the cares of the world, the lust of things, and the deceitfulness of riches shall have no influence on the Word sown in our hearts, except to build experience, hope, confidence, trust, and increase in the Word, making us stronger in the Lord and the power of His might, enabling us to bind Satan and his angels.

(James 5): Come now, ye rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you. Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten. Your gold and your silver are rusted, and their rust shall be a testimony against you, and shall eat your flesh as fire. You have laid up your treasure in the last days. Behold, the hire of the laborers who reaped your fields that you have withheld by fraud, cries out, and the cries of them that reaped have entered into the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth.

(Ecclesiastes 2): To the sinner You give travail, to gather and to heap up, that You may give to those who please You, and, Lord, we desire to please You.

(Romans 8, I Corinthians 2): Lord, we know that to them that love You, all things work together for good for those who are called according to your purpose, and we are determined to fulfill the purpose You have designed for our lives. It is written, eye has not seen, ear has not heard, neither has entered into the heart of mankind, those things God has prepared for those who love Him. But unto us God revealed them through the Spirit, for the Spirit searches all things, yea, the deep things of God, the divine counsels and things hidden from carnal scrutiny.

(Isaiah 48): Thus says the Lord God Jehovah, I, even I, have spoken; yea, I have called Him; I have brought Him, and He shall make your way prosperous. Come near unto your God, Jehovah, hear this; from the beginning I have not spoken in secret; from the beginning of time, there am I; and now the Lord Jehovah has sent the Word, and His Spirit. Thus says Jehovah, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; "I am Jehovah your God, who teaches you to profit, who leads you in the way you should go. Harken to my Word and your peace and prosperity shall flow like a river, and your righteousness as the waves of the sea; your descendants shall be as the grains of sand, and your name will not be cut off nor destroyed from before the Lord God Jehovah." Lord we shall be attentive to your Word, guide our steps and our affairs, teach us to profit, and our peace and prosperity shall flow like a river, and our descendants shall be blessed.

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(Psalms 121:7-8; Numbers 6:24-26; Romans 15:13): Lord preserve our going out and coming in from this time forth, and for evermore. Bless us and keep us, let your face shine upon us, and be gracious unto us, lift up your countenance upon us, and give us peace. Fill us with joy and peace in believing, that we may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

(Colossians 1:9-12): I pray that my spiritual family will be filled with the knowledge of your will with all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that we might walk worthy of You Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to your glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness. We give thanks unto our Father, you have made partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light; you have delivered us from the power of darkness, and have translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son; in whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins; who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature; for by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and in earth, visible and invisible, whether they are thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers; all things were created by Him, and for Him; and He is before all things, and by Him all things consist. He is the head of the body, the church; who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; in all things He has preeminence. In Him all fullness dwells; He has made peace through the blood of His cross, and has reconciled all things unto Himself; whether they be things in earth, or heaven; and He has reconciled us through His death and presents us blameless before God the Father.

(Ephesians 1, 2): Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, having chosen us before the foundation of the world, that we should be consecrated and blameless in His sight in love, having foreordained us to be His adopted children through Jesus Christ, according to His pleasure and His will, to the praise of His glorious grace, which he freely bestowed on us in our beloved Jesus. In You we have our redemption through your blood, the forgiveness of our sins, in accordance with the riches of your grace, which You lavished upon us with every kind of wisdom, understanding, insight, and prudence. You have made known unto us the mystery of your will, your plan, and your purpose, in accordance with your mercy and grace, which You purposed, that in the fullness of time and climax of the ages to unify all things and consummate them in Christ, both things in heaven, and the things in the earth. In Christ we were given a heritage and inheritance, for we have been foreordained according to your purpose, your counsel, and your will, that we should live for the praise of Your glory (not ours). In You we have heard, believed, and trusted in the Word of truth, the gospel of our salvation, and we were sealed with the Holy Spirit as promised, which is the guarantee of our inheritance, in anticipation of full redemption, to be God's own possession, to the praise of Your glory. We give thanks for God's children, our spiritual family, and pray that You will give us a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the intimate knowledge of You, having the eyes of our heart enlightened, so that we may know the hope of your calling, the glorious riches of the inheritance given to your children, and the exceeding greatness of your power given to us, according to the strength of your might which You created in Christ, when You raised Him from the dead, and made Him to sit at your right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule, and authority, and power, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come. Jesus is the King of Glory, the King of kings, the Lord of lords, the Lion of Judah, and You have placed all things in subjection under His feet, and made Him the head over all things in the church, which is His body in the earth appointed to complete His work. And to us who were once dead in bondage and sin, He is Immanuel, God with us, our hope of glory, and You have made us alive in Christ and anointed us, and given us authority in the heavenly realm that You might clearly demonstrate through the ages, the limitless riches of your mercy, grace, lovingkindness, and goodness towards us in Christ Jesus.

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We exercise our authority over Satan and his angels; and in the name of Jesus, we bind them from harming God's children or hindering us from completing God's work in the earth. We command Satan to return everything he has stolen from us and repay sevenfold. The angels of God are commissioned to gather the wealth of the wicked to expand the Kingdom of God.

(Ephesians 3): We worship You Jehovah, and we ask You to grant us, according to the riches of your glory, to be strengthened with power through your Spirit in our inner man; that Christ may dwell in our hearts through faith, that we, being rooted and grounded in love, may know the breadth and length and height and depth of the love of Christ which passes carnal knowledge, and that we may be filled with the richest measure of the presence and fullness of God. You are able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us. Unto You be glory in the church by Christ Jesus unto all generations forever.

(Ephesians 4): Lord we thank You for the apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers for our perfecting so we can be built up, minister to others, attain unity of the faith, and knowledge of the Son of God, so that we can grow unto the stature and fullness of Christ. We pray that we will no longer be as children, influenced and persuaded with twisted doctrines of cunning and unscrupulous people; rather let us speak the truth in love, develop, expand and increase in the things of Christ, who is the head. Let the body of Christ on the earth be fitly framed, closely knit, and strengthened together through the effective work of every member and grow to full maturity, strengthening one another in love.

We pray we will no longer walk as the ungodly walk, in the vanity of their mind, being darkened in their understanding and alienated from the life of God, because of their ignorance and hardening hearts. We abandon our former manner of life and the old corrupt man, and desire to be renewed in the spirit of our mind. We put on the new man, who has been created and ordained by our God, in righteousness, holiness, and truth. Let the words of our mouth and the meditation of our heart be acceptable in your sight, and let no corrupt speech proceed out of our mouth, but let us edify others, and give grace to them that hear. Do not let us grieve the Holy Spirit of God, in whom we are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let us abandon all bitterness, anger, rage, contention, slander, wicked speech, and malice; let us be kind and compassionate to others, and forgiving as God in Christ forgave us.

(Ephesians 6): Let us be strong in the Lord and in the power of your might and put on the whole armor of God, that we might be able to stand against the wiles of the devil, for we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, rulers of darkness, and spiritual wickedness. Let us put on the breastplate of righteousness and integrity, that we may be victorious, having our loins bound with truth, and our feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace. Let us take the shield of faith, quenching all the fiery darts of the evil one, the helmet of salvation, and the sword that the Spirit wields, which is the Word of God, with prayer and supplication for the saints, watching and praying during all seasons in the Spirit. Let us be empowered and anointed by the Holy Spirit to proclaim Your Word, Your Truth, and Your Gospel. We pray the Holy Spirit will have free course to minister, heal, deliver and meet the needs of the people, and we pray the lost will come to the knowledge of truth and make Jesus Christ the Lord of their life.

(Philippians 1, 2, 3, 4): We pray that our love may abound in knowledge and discernment; so that we may approve the things that are excellent, that we may be sincere and void of offence, being filled with the fruits of righteousness, through Jesus Christ, for the glory and praise of God. Let us exhort in Christ, speak the truth in love, console in love, and fellowship in the Spirit, show tender mercies and compassion, and be in unity, having the mind of Christ, and having the same love, and doing nothing through division, pride, conceit, vanity, or arrogance, but in meekness let us appreciate, regard, respect, and care for others. God has highly exalted our Lord Jesus Christ and given Him the name, which is above every name, that in the name of Jesus every knee shall bow, of things in heaven and things on earth and things under the earth, and that every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Lord work in us and through us for your good pleasure, and let us do all things in your glorious name, without murmuring, questioning, criticizing or complaining, that we may be blameless and harmless, children of God, without blemish in the midst of a wicked and perverse generation. Let us be seen as lights in the world, holding forth the Word of life and rejoicing in the Lord. We consider worldly things to be as garbage, that we may gain Christ, and be found in Him, not having our own righteousness, but the righteousness which is from God by faith in Christ, that we may know Him, and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, becoming conformed unto His death. Not that we have already attained, but we press on to apprehend that for which we were apprehended by Christ Jesus, and we shall focus on one thing; forgetting the past and expectantly looking to the future, we shall press toward the goal for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. Let us therefore, have the mind of Christ, humble ourselves and become obedient servants. Let us stand fast in the Lord, and rejoice in the Lord always and be anxious in nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving make our requests to God, and the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall guard our hearts and thoughts in Christ Jesus. Whatsoever things are true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, of good report, virtuous, or worthy of praise, let us think on these things. We can do all things in Christ who strengthens us, and our God shall supply our every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

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Heavenly Father we ask You to hear our praise, thanksgiving, & prayers. You are Jehovah Shalom to us, You are our peace; Jehovah Jireh, our provider; Jehovah Raha, our Shepherd; Jehovah Rapha, our Healer; Jehovah Nissi, our Victor and Banner; Jehovah Tsidkenu, our Righteousness; and Jehovah Shammah, our ever present help.
